Petitioner's grievance is relating to seeking writ of *mandamus* to respondent Nos.1 to 3 for failure to reply the notice under Section 80 of the CPC. Further petitioner has sought for a direction to restrain the employer-management of 4th respondent from selling their property without first payment of workmen's wages and settlement of workmen's dues. 4th respondent do not fall under Article 12 of the Constitution of India. Therefore, any grievance of the petitioner in respect of 4th respondent and any control of respondent No.1 to 3 over the 4th respondent, writ petition is not maintainable.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
