The petitioner sought admission in B.A. L.L.B.(Hons.) 5 years' Course in the Institute of Law in Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra against one of the seat reserved for 'Outstanding Sports Persons'. Though in para No.9 of the writ petition itself, it is averred that every candidate was required to submit Gradation Certificate issued by the Director of Sports and Youth Welfare, Government of Haryana, however, it is the conceded position that neither the petitioner has obtained such Gradation Certificate nor it was obviously attached with the application form.

Since the petitioner has now taken a plea that respondent No.4 has been admitted without such certificate, we dispose of this writ petition by directing the Registrar of Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra to consider this writ petition as a representation on behalf of the petitioner and decide his claim by way of a reasoned order within a period of two weeks from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
