By virtue of instant civil writ petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ particularly in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the previous service of the petitioner under H.S.M.I.T.C. w.e.f. 10/1984 to 14.10.2001 as a qualifying service for all intents and purposes except seniority and further to release the retiral benefits i.e. Gratuity, pension, leave encashment, GIS & GPF etc. along with all consequential benefits with interest @ 18% per annum from the date of retirement till the date of actual payment.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a legal notice was issued to the respondents on June 01, 2017 (Annexure P-4) but

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neither any reply to the aforesaid legal notice has been received nor any final order has been passed by the respondents.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents No.2 & 3 to decide legal notice dated June 01, 2017 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner.

4. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his Legal Notice dated June 01, 2017 (Annexure P-4) and pass a speaking order in terms of judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.24340 of 2016 captioned as ***Om Parkash and another vs. State of Haryana and others*** decided on March 24, 2017 as well as retiral benefits within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feel aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
