Admittedly, Punjab Bovine Breeding Act, 2016 has been enacted w.e.f. 14.5.2016. Petitioner is, thus, at liberty to make necessary application under the said Act. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would move necessary application before the competent authority in view of provisions of the said Act.

Stand of the State is that any application, if found maintainable, shall be considered as per law.

Under the circumstances, no further direction is necessary. Petition is hereby disposed of. Petitioner shall, however, be at liberty to seek revival of the petition or file afresh if any cause of action survives.
