The grievance of the petitioners is that against the eviction order dated 27.04.2017 passed under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, as applicable to the State of Haryana, they have filed a statutory appeal but without considering their request for stay, efforts are being made to execute the eviction order.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioners and considering the nature of relief sought in this writ petition, the same is disposed of with a direction to the Appellate Authority to decide the stay matter within two weeks. The main appeal be also decided within three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Till such time, *status-quo* re: demolition of the house be maintained.
