By virtue of the civil writ petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to start monthly financial assistance of the petitioner being 87 years old mother of deceased government employee as per Haryana Compassionate Assistance to the dependants of Deceased Government Employees Rules, 2006 and to make the payment of arrears with w.e.f. December, 2016 with 18% interest per annum.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a legal notice dated 27.04.2017 (Annexure P-6) was served upon the respondents and but no decision has been taken till date. The learned counsel further submitted that he feels satisfied in case, the concerned authorities are directed to deal with and dispose of the claim of petitioner set up in the legal notice dated 27.04.2017 (Annexure P-6) within some specified period.

Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to official respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her legal notice dated 27.04.2017 (Annexure P-6) and to take a conscious decision that too by passing a speaking order, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

In case, the petitioner still feels aggrieved of any adverse order passed by the concerned authority, she shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
