Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that similarly situated employees filed ***CWP No.22668 of 2016*** before this Court and the same was disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners in terms of order passed in ***CWP No.12023 of 2015*** within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioners have served legal notice on 01.05.2017 but no action has been taken thereupon so far. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioners would be satisfied, in case, the directions are issued by this Court to consider legal notice dated 01.05.2017, which is annexed as Annexure P-5 with the petition.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioners, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider the case of the petitioners in terms of order passed in

CWP No.12023 of 2015 within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

However, in case, the petitioners are found to be entitled for the relief sought for in the legal notice, the same be granted to them within a period of two months thereafter.

In case, the petitioners are still aggrieved in any manner, they are at liberty to avail the appropriate remedy.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
