In the instant writ petition, petitioner has challenged the validity of Labour Court award dated 2.3.2017. The petitioner's contention is that he has worked from 18.2.2001 to 15.12.2012 as a Machine Operator. To support the contention that he has rendered service from 2001 to 2012 except Annexure P-3, no document has been placed on record to substantiate the contention that he has worked from 2001 to 2012. From the perusal of Annexure P-3 which is stated to be compromise document between the workers and the Management, it is evident that Annexure P-3 dated 20.10.2012 is not attested by seal and signature and the signature of MW-1 is being disputed by MW-1 – Sh. Sumit. In view of these facts and circumstances and the fact that petitioner failed to establish that his services have been engaged by the respondent from 2001 to 2012, no other document has been placed on record. Therefore, there is no infirmity in the award passed by the Labour Court dated 2.3.2017.

Petition stands dismissed.
