Counsel for the petitioner challenges the transfer order dated 03.08.2017 (Annexure P-4) without having approached the respondents for the redressal of her grievances allegedly on the ground that the petitioner's case is covered under a Couple Case Policy. Nothing has been attached with the writ petition even to show that the petitioner has raised her grievances before the competent authority.

In these circumstances, it is settled principle that the transfer order's are not to be interfered with in the absence of malafide's. Accordingly, faced with this situation, counsel prays for liberty to approach the respondents at the first instance, for the redressal of his grievances.
