The petitioner's grievance in the instant writ petition is that an eviction order was allegedly passed against the private-respondents way back on 30.06.1986, against which no appeal was filed by them and it has attained finality. It is alleged that the Gram Panchayat is not taking any action for execution of that order and for restoration of its possession over the land unauthorizedly occupied by private-respondents. A direction is thus sought for execution of that order.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner but without expressing any views on merits moreso when we have not heard the respondents at this stage, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the DDPO, Kaithal to look into the matter and if need be, issue necessary direction to the Gram Panchayat to do the needful in the matter.

Let the needful be done within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
