By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to hold that service rendered by petitioner in Govt. Aided Schools is countable towards qualifying service for revised pension and pensionary benefits alongwith all consequential benefits, especially in view of rules governing his conditions of service as well as settled law as laid in CWP No.14328 of 1991, Sukhdev Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab and others, decided on 10.03.2010 (Annexure P-7) along with interest @ 18% per annum.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though a legal notice dated 20.01.2017 (Annexure P-8) was served upon the respondents and but no decision has been taken till date.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to official respondent(s) to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated 20.01.2017 (Annexure P-8) keeping in view the judgment which has been referred in the legal notice as well as rules and instructions

given to the petitioner. In case the concerned authority comes to the conclusion that the petitioner is entitled to the benefits claimed by him, to release/disburse the same within next 45 days.

If petitioner feels aggrieved of this order, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court again.
