The petitioner's grievance in the instant writ petition is that the respondents have not given the requisite quota of 27% seats to the 'OBC Category' candidate in MBBS/BDS Courses against 15% All India Quota.

As per the Information Bulletin published by the Central Board of Secondary Education, Delhi, 27% seats in All India Quota are reserved for OBC in Central Institutes. The question whether such reservation in every Central Institute has been provided or not is a question of fact. We thus dispose of this writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to represent the authorities with a specific information whether every Central Institute has been provided such quota or not. We direct the Authority concerned that if any such representation is made, let the factual claim raised by the petitioner be examined and decided within a period of one week from the date of receiving such representation.

Ordered accordingly.
