This order shall dispose of CWP Nos.4953 and 24928 of 2012 as the point in issue involved in both the cases is similar. For brevity, facts and being extracted from CWP No.4953 of 2012.

The petitioners have sought for a direction to the respondents to release allowances to Attorneys for library/books and similar requisites w.e.f. 28.3.2006 as approved in public interest by the then Hon'ble Chief

Minister of Haryana on 28.3.2006 (Annexure P-1). In respect of pay scale of all the Attorneys in the State of Haryana is under consideration with reference to decision of this Court passed in CWP No.14166 of 2014 disposed of on 25.10.2016. The State has constituted a Committee headed by the Chief Secretary, Haryana and other members. Grievance of the petitioners relating to allowance is concerned is also one of the item which would be considered by the Committee for the reasons that while appointing the Committee, it is stated that the Committee shall examine the issues of pay scale etc. as request made by Haryana Attorneys Welfare Association. Therefore, the learned State counsel submitted that even the grievance of the petitioners-Attorneys i.e. allowances would be considered by the Committee. In this regard, the petitioners are at liberty to make necessary application or representation before the Committee headed by the Chief Secretary Haryana vide order dated 4.11.2016. Such representation or application, if any, shall be submitted by the petitioners within a period of two weeks from today. If such representation or application is made before the Committee, the same shall be considered while examining the issues of pay scale etc. including the allowances demanded by the attorneys. The Committee shall take decision within a period of six months.

Petitions stand disposed of.
