The claim in the instant writ petition was to revise the result of the petitioners, keeping in view the decision of the expert committee constituted to evaluate the answer keys of the PSTET (Paper-II) test undertaken.

Learned counsel for the respondents-State supplies copy of the order dated 26.04.2017 passed by Mr. Sukhdev Singh, Director, SCERT, Punjab in the court today, which is taken on record as Mark 'X' and submits that in view of the judgment rendered in CWP No.25794 of 2015 titled as *“Ekta Sharma and others vs. State of Punjab and others”* decided on 18.05.2016, the result of the petitioners herein has been revised and by

giving them additional marks on the basis of the report of the expert committee dated 12.10.2015, both the petitioners have been declared as pass.
