By the impugned order, the petitioner was repatriated from the Haryana Technical Society (sponsored by the Technical Education Department) to his substantive post of Lecturer Mathematics.

Counsel for the petitioner has argued that the order was passed mala fide.

Be that as it may, a deputation order can be terminated by any of the three parties to the same and does not create any right in any party to maintain it against the wishes of any one of the other parties. Consequently, finding no merit in this writ petition, the same is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
