The services of the petitioner were regularized as Peon (Class IV Post) vide order dated 06.02.2015 (**P-6**) on account of her previous engagement as a part time sweeper since April 1994. The said order of regularization was cancelled vide a subsequent order dated 6.6.2016 (**P-10**) passed by the District Education Officer, Gurdaspur upon inquiry qua the veracity of the School Leaving Certificate furnished by the petitioner. The petitioner filed a statutory appeal dated 16.07.2016 (**P-11**) against the order dated 6.6.2016 (**P-10**).

The prayer was restricted to issuance of a direction to the Appellate Authority i.e. the Director Secondary Education, Punjab to decide the pending appeal at the earliest qua the cancellation of order of

regularization.

Upon notice learned State Counsel on instructions from Mr. Gurmukh Singh, Senior Assistant, office of DPI (SE), Punjab submits that the petitioner has been summoned for personal hearing on 01.03.2017 in the pending appeal and the said appeal in all probabilities will be decided within one month from today.

In view of the above, present petition is disposed of with direction to the Statutory Authority to dispose of the pending appeal within two months from today by passing a speaking order.
