The challenge in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is to order dated 17.09.2015 passed by respondent No.3 (**Annexure P-1**) directing the Circle Revenue Officer to take over the possession of the property of the petitioner on behalf of respondent No.4 i.e. residential house situated at Gate No.2, Prem Basti, Sangrur.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner states that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition. However, a prayer was made that liberty be granted to the petitioner to approach the Debts Recovery Tribunal to raise all the grievances as raised in the present writ petition.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn, It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to her, in accordance with law.
