In the instant petition, petitioner has challenged the validity of the award passed by the Labour Court dated 17.10.2012. Petitioner's stand before the Labour Court is that he was appointed by the respondent as a Painter during the period from 1.2.1992 till Ist December 1999. Whereas the Labour Court recorded in para-13 of the award that the petitioner has worked from 1992 till December 1999 but has failed to prove he has ever worked after December 1993. Thereafter, no material has been placed on record during the pendency of this petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner produced muster roll relating to 1996-97. However, same is not authenticated. Moreover, petitioner failed to make necessary application before the Labour Court for summoning relevant records to show that he has worked from February 1992 till December 1999. In the absence of the same, no error is found from the Labour Court award.

According, petition stands dismissed.
