The only direction prayed for in this writ petition is to direct the respondents to remove illegal possession from the shamlat land. It appears that the Assistant Collector, 1st Grade, Panipat passed eviction order dated 31.05.2013 which is not being executed and thus unauthorized occupation over shamlat land continues. The aggrieved petitioner has filed this writ petition seeking implementation of that order.

Meanwhile appeal is stated to have been filed against the order dated 31.05.2013 and the Collector, Panipat vide order dated 26.08.2016 has stayed the order of Assistant Collector, 1st Grade, Panipat. Obviously till that stay order is operative, the eviction order cannot be executed.

However, if after exhausting all the legal remedies the eviction order attains finality, it shall be obligatory on the authorities to implement the same without wastage of time. We thus dispose of this writ petition as

infructuous at this stage with liberty to the petitioner to seek implementation of the eviction order in future, if need be.

Ordered accordingly.
