Present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the
Constitution of India for setting aside the order dated 05.03.2014
(Annexure-P4) and 26.09.2014 (Annexure-P6).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submitted that
on an earlier occasion representation had been filed seeking the relief as
claimed in the writ petition. It was further submitted that a fresh
comprehensive and detailed representation will be filed with respondent
No.2 and it was prayed that a direction be issued to respondent No.2 to
decide the same expeditiously after affording an opportunity of hearing
to the petitioner.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent states in case any

representation that may be filed by the petitioner, shall be decided expeditiously in accordance with law.

4. After hearing learned counsel for the parties, we dispose of the present petition with the direction that petitioner shall be entitled to file a detail and comprehensive representation within a period of 15 days from today and in case such representation is filed with respondent No.2, the same shall be decided by the competent authority within next two months after affording an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and by passing a speaking order.
