Pursuant to the order dated 07.07.2017, an affidavit of Sh.Ram Kumar, General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Kaithal, has been filed in Court today, to the effect that in fact the sealed cover was opened and pursuant to that, interviews of the petitioners, Sandeep Kumar and Randhir

Singh, were held at Kaithal, and after adding the marks obtained by them in

the interview in their respective categories, as also the marks assignable to them as per their academic qualifications, Sandeep Kumar (petitioner in CWP-8752-2016) has obtained 13.03 marks, but since the last selected candidate in the general category has obtained 14.813 marks, appointment cannot be given to Sandeep Kumar.

However, as regards Randhir Singh, since he has obtained 7.42 marks in all, does make it to the merit list for appointment as a driver, with the last candidate in the merit list of the S.C. category having obtained only 4.96 marks in the merit list.

With the aforesaid reply having been filed making the aforesaid position clear, learned counsel for the petitioner does not deny that these petitions have been rendered infructuous, and it is therefore, disposed of as such.

The appointment to the selected candidate would obviously follow in due course, as per appointments given to other candidates selected, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
