By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant the benefit of promotional increment(s) to the petitioner, in view of the circular dated 23.04.1990 (Annexure P-1), especially in view of the judgments passed by this Hon'ble Court in CWP No. 20139 of 2015 (Annexure P-6) and CWP No. 10689 of 2016 (Annexure P-7) by which the benefit of 23 years promotional increment has already been granted to the similar situated employees with further prayer to release the benefit to the petitioner alongwith @ 18% interest.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a legal notice dated November 18, 2016 (Annexure P-8) was served upon the respondents but till date no action has been taken on the same. He feels satisfied in case a direction

is issued to respondent No.1 to consider and dispose of the legal notice dated November 18, 2016 (Annexure P-8) within a stipulated period.

Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the legal notice dated November 18, 2016 (Annexure P-8) and to decide the same within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, that too in view of circular dated April 23, 1990 (Annexure P-1), judgments passed by this Court in the case of **Chiman Singh vs. Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. & Others**; CWP No. 20139 of 2015, decided on February 29, 2016 (Annexure P-6) and judgement dated May 26, 2016 passed in CWP No. 10689 of 2016 titled as **Gursharan Singh vs. Punjab State Power Corporation Ltd. & others.**
