The petitioner has challenged the transfer of respondent no.6 to the Government Middle School, Shobhapur, vide the impugned order, Annexure P-2, as the petitioner is already working as an Elementary School Headmaster at the said school.

Pursuant to the order dated 21.11.2017, a short reply of Shri Dilbag Singh, Joint Director (in the office of the Director, Elementary Education, Haryana) has been filed in Court today in which it has been stated that undoubtedly the petitioner is Elementary School Headmaster and not a Trained Graduate Teacher (TGT), but as on the portal (on the website of the respondent department), he was shown to be a TGT, the mistake has occurred in transferring respondent no.6 to the Government Girls Middle School, Shobhapur, in place of the petitioner, where the said respondent has already joined.

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As regards the petitioners' contention to the effect that he had represented for correction of his status as a TGT on the website, it has been stated in the affidavit that, as a matter of fact, even the teacher himself could have done so, which was not done and therefore, with respondent no.6 having joined at Shobhapur, the petitioner has been posted to the Government Middle School, Rajpura, also in District Mahendergarh, which on query learned counsel for the State submits is 15 kms away from Shobhapur.

That being so, I see no reason to continue with this petition, which is consequently dismissed, with the contention of the petitioner rejected, to the effect that it was not the petitioners' fault that his status was wrongly shown on the website, when a specific affidavit has been filed to the effect that he himself could have corrected the status, instead of representing time and again.
