By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release pension of late Gaurav Sharma Constable in Punjab Armed Police on Sports Quota in the year 2002 and later promoted as ASI.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a legal notice dated March 25, 2017 (Annexure P-7) was served upon the respondents but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide the same within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his legal notice dated March 25, 2017 (Annexure P-7) and to decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order that too, after hearing the petitioner, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However, if the petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
