The petitioner is a resident of village Ladhian Kalan, P.O. Bagga Khurd, Tehsil and District Ludhiana. He had earlier approached this Court through CWP No.7140 of 2013 (Jaspreet Singh Gill and others versus State of Punjab and others) seeking directions to the Gram Panchayat to perform its statutory duties and get the encroachments removed from *shamlat deh*. The writ petition was disposed of on 12.04.2013 with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana and the BDPO, Ludhiana-II to do the needful and take appropriate action for removal of the unauthorized occupants from the *shamlat deh*. It is alleged that pursuant to those directions, the Gram Panchayat filed eviction petition under Section 7 of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961 and the resultant eviction order was also passed against the encroachers. Their appeal has also been dismissed. However, no further action is being taken by the Gram Panchayat to seek execution of the eviction order.

If that be so, we dispose of this writ petition with a direction to the Deputy Commissioner, Ludhiana, D.D.P.O. and B.D.P.O., Ludhiana, to

look into the matter and take necessary action for execution of the eviction

orders if the same have attained finality.

Let the needful be done within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
