JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant ACP increment which was due after the completion of 23 years of service in the department of respondents as per guidelines issued by Government of Punjab.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though legal notice dated 16.02.2017 (Annexure P-1) was duly served upon the respondents but till date no action has been taken. He further submits that petitioners feel satisfied in case direction is issued to respondents to decide the aforementioned legal notice, within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioners in their legal notice dated 16.02.2017 (Annexure P-1) and take a conscious decision, by passing a speaking order, within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case, the petitioners still feel aggrieved against the order passed by respondents, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
