JASPAL SINGH, J (ORAL)

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the retiral benefits i.e. pension, gratuity, leave encashment, GPF etc along-with interest @18% per annum.

2. A glance at the reply dated July 07, 2017 filed by respondents No.3 and 4 reveals that gratuity, leave encashment and provident fund have already been disbursed to the petitioner. Further, the pension case of the petitioner has already been sanctioned vide PPO No. 7328 and after the pension was sanctioned, it is being paid regularly to the petitioner.

3. Thus, in view of submission made in the afore-said reply, instant petition has rendered infructuous and as such is dismissed.

4. At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that some of the amount is still outstanding including interest, which has not been paid by the respondents.

5. However, a liberty is granted to the petitioner to move a detailed representation to the respondents in respect of his claim, if any left, which shall be dealt with and disposed of, in accordance with law in reasonable time
