The petitioner challenges the appointment of respondents No.4 and 5 on the post of Assistant Professor in the Department of Printing Technology of respondent No.1. The petitioner has got 73 marks as per merit in the General Category. Three posts were advertised, out of which one was for General, one for BC-A and one was for ESM. Respondent No.4 belongs to the reserved category of BC-A and has secured 84 marks and has been appointed in the General Category.

Because a reserved candidate has secured more marks than the petitioner, who has only secured 73 marks, respondent No.4 has duly been adjusted in the General Category.

Thus, there can be no quarrel about the selection process, since a reserved candidate has got more marks than the petitioner in the General Category and he is entitled for the appointment.

Resultantly, the present writ petition is without any merit and same is dismissed in limine.
