By virtue of instant civil writ petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the payment of medical reimbursement bill of the petitioner amounting to Rs.1,20,000/- and Rs.5945/- in respect of his wife Smt. Sosan.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, it has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to file a fresh representation before the concerned authorities.

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3. In view of statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.

4. However, respondents are directed, in case, any representation is made for the payment of above said medical bills, same shall be considered as per latest rules and instructions within a period of two months.
