The petitioner has challenged the order dated 18.06.2015 (Annexure P-9) whereby his name for selection to Armed Force has been rejected. Petitioner is a candidate for recruitment to the post of Soldier (General Duty). His name was rejected due to the deficiency of medical examination. Consequently, petitioner was examined by the PGIMER, Chandigarh and favourable report has been given in respect of petitioner's medical examination (Annexure P-7). The Division Bench in **CWP No. 10900 of 2014 Govind V/s. Union of India and others**, decided on 16.12.2014 directed the concerned authority to take note of fresh medical examination report.

Petition is allowed and the order dated 18.06.2015 is set aside. The selecting and appointing authority are hereby directed to reconsider the petitioner's name for selection and appointment to the post of Soldier in terms of the medical examination report by PGIMER (Annexure P-7) read with the decision passed in Govind's case (supra). The above exercise shall be

completed by the competent authority within three months from today and communicate the decision to the petitioner.

With these observations, Civil Writ Petition stands allowed.
