The prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to remove the liquor vends which have been opened in violation of the orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court in SLP(C) 14911 to 14913 of 2013, dated 15.12.2016 (Annexure P-1). Further prayer has also been made to direct the respondents to decide the representation of the petitioner dated 12.06.2017 (Annexure P-4) within some stipulated period.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition to pursue the representation dated 12.06.2017 (Annexure P-4) which has already been filed by the petitioner with the concerned respondents.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to him, in accordance with law.
