The impugned order dated 13.06.2017 (copy issued on 22.06.2017) has been passed by the Debt Recovery Tribunal-II, Chandigarh. The said order is appealable before the learned Debt Recovery Appellate Tribunal.

Since the petitioners have got an efficacious alternative remedy, the instant writ petition is disposed of with liberty to approach the Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal. However, with a view to enable the petitioners to file appeal before the Appellate Tribunal, it is directed that *status-quo* re: dispossession shall be maintained for a period of two weeks. The petitioners may seek further extension of the interim order from the Appellate Tribunal.
