The short grievance of the petitioner-Gram Panchayat in this case is that the eviction order dated 23.04.2013 (P-2) passed against the private-respondents has attained finality as no appeal was filed against that order. The official respondents, however, are taking no interest in executing/giving effect to that order. Resultantly, encroachment on the Gram Panchayat land still subsists.

In view of the above-stated categorical stand taken by the petitioner-Gram Panchayat, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.2 to 5 to take necessary action in accordance with law for the execution of eviction order dated 23.04.2013. The needful shall be done within a period of three months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
