The petitioners allege that office bearers of the Gram Panchayat of their village are, on the pretext of levelling of the *shamlat deh* land, are indulging in illegal mining, hence a direction be issued to the authorities to take action against them.

We find from the record that pursuant to the complaints made by the petitioners or other residents of the village, a vigilance inquiry is already going on. Still further, the petitioners have served the authorities with a legal notice dated 27.07.2017 (P-10). However, without awaiting any response thereto, the instant writ petition has been filed.

Owing to the factual issues raised by the petitioners, we do not express any views on merits and deem it appropriate to dispose of this writ petition with a direction to respondent Nos.3 to 6, 8, 9 & 10 to consider the legal notice served on behalf of the petitioners and take appropriate action

in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of

receiving a certified copy of this order.
