By virtue of instant civil writ petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant 2nd and 3rd ACP with all consequential benefits to the petitioners which is due since 2006 and further to re-fix the pay of the petitioners as per their entitlement of 2nd and 3rd ACP and pension also be revised as new pay scale.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a legal notice dated January 09, 2017 (Annexure P-3) has been served upon the respondents but no action is being taken and they would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondents No.1 & 3 to consider and decide the said legal notice within a specified period. Learned counsel for

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the petitioner further submits that this case is covered by the judgment dated April 27, 2016 (Annexure P-4) passed by this Court in CWP No.10051 of 2013, captioned as ***Prithvi Singh vs. State of Haryana & Ors.*** and another judgment dated July 24, 2015 (Annexure P-5) passed in CWP No.23074 of 2010 captioned as ***Ram Pal Patwari & Ors. vs. State of Haryana & Ors.***

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.1 & 3 to take a decision on the legal notice dated January 09, 2017 (Annexure P-3) by passing a speaking order in view of the judgments passed by this Court, referred to herein above, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
