Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioners' transfer out of Rohtak, to Delhi, is against the policy of the respondents (Annexure P-1), by which, at sr. no.4, it is stated that a person who is suffering from a handicap or a chronic disease would not be relieved and in his place, the next employee with a longer stay would be relieved.

On query as to what is the handicap suffered by the petitioner, it is stated that the petitioners' right arm stands amputated.

In respect of his grievance, the petitioner is stated to have made an undated representation to the competent authority, a copy of which is shown at Annexure P-3.

Consequently, this petition is disposed of with a direction to competent authority to take a decision on the aforesaid representation of the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
