By virtue of instant petition preferred under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release all the retiral benefits to the petitioner along with interest @ 18% per annum with further prayer directing the respondents to pay interest @ 18% per annum on delayed payment in view of law down in the case of *Charan Dass Vs. State of Punjab and others* vide judgment dated July 11, 2017.

At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3-Executive Engineer to decide representation dated 07.06.2017 (Annexure P-1) within a stipulated period.

Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to official respondent No.3-Executive Engineer to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his representation dated 07.06.2017 (Annexure P-1) and to decide the same in accordance with law particularly keeping in view the judgment passed by this Court in CWP No.8772 of 2015 decided on

11.07.2017 titled as *Charan Dass Vs. State of Punjab and others*, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. If the petitioner still aggrieved of any order passed by the authorities concerned, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
