The matter has been discussed.

It may be mentioned here that this matter was earlier fixed before the Lok Adalat and vide order dated 11.11.2010 a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by ₹ 1,35,200/- over and above the amount already granted by the MACT concerned. However, the case was sent back to the Hon'ble High Court on 25.3.2011 as the Insurance Company had made a counter offer of ₹ 92,000/- which was not acceptable to learned counsel for the appellants.

The case has again been put up before the Lok Adalat to reconsider the matter to bring about amicable settlement.

As agreed, as per statements of the representative of the Insurance Company and counsel for the appellants, (separately recorded today), a sum of ₹ 3,50,000/- (Rs.Three Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) more, over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants the enhanced amount would be paid to appellant No.1-Sarabjit Kaur wd/o Sh. Darshan Singh.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of ₹ 3,50,000/- in the name

of appellant No.1-Sarabjit Kaur wd/o Sh. Darshan Singh with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 23.10.2017 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellants' counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
