By virtue of instant civil writ petition preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioners have sought the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to revise the pensionary/retiral benefits of the petitioners including revised gratuity, leave encashment, arrears of pension and pay on account of re-designation and placement of the petitioners as Junior Assistant in terms of order dated May 06, 2016 (Annexure P-2) along with interest @ 18% per annum on delayed payments.

2. At the very outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that a legal notice dated January 01, 2017 (Annexure P-5) has been served to the respondents for the necessary relief but no action is being taken and

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they would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent Nos.3 & 4 to consider and decide the said legal notice within a specified period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.3 & 4 to take a decision on the legal notice dated January 01, 2017 (Annexure P-5) in terms of CWP No.4913 of 2016 decided on March 16, 2016 captioned as ***Vijay Kumar and Ors. vs. State of Punjab and Ors.*** passed by this Court within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioners still feel aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, they shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
