The petitioners have approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned order dated 03.08.2017 (Annexure P-5) vide which the tender has been allotted to respondent No.5, ineligible candidate in complete violation of the provision of tender document, Annexure P-1 particularly sub paras ix and x of para no.13 and other relevant provisions being arbitrary, passed without jurisdiction, unconstitutional, oppressive, punitive in nature, discriminatory and violative of Articles 14 and 16 of Constitution of India and contrary to public policy and the principles of natural justice.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition

with liberty to the petitioners to pursue the representation which has been filed before the authorities concerned.

- 3. Dismissed as withdrawn.
- 4. However, it shall be open to the petitioners to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to them, in accordance with law.
