1.) In the instant writ petition, the petitioner has sought for a direction to the respondents to appoint him as a Computer Operator and further sought for a direction for payment of salary for the period from 30.6.2009 to 15.7.2011.

2.) The petitioner is stated to have been engaged as a Computer Operator on contract basis for the period from 8.4.2009 to 30.06.2009 at the DC rate of ₹ 4,680/- vide Annexure R-1 on 15.4.2009. The petitioner services are ceased to be existing as on 01.07.2009 having regard to the office order dated 15.4.2009. The petitioner has approached this Court on earlier occasion seeking for appointment on contract basis in the year 2010. This Court refused to entertain his petition. In fact he had filed one more litigation in the year 2011. The same was also dismissed. Learned counsel

had preferred an LPA and the LPA was rejected. In this background question for consideration is whether the petitioner is entitled for direction to the respondents to appoint him as a Computer Operator or not and further is he entitled for arrears of salary for the period from 30.6.2009 to 15.7.2011 or not. Admittedly, the petitioner has not worked beyond 30.6.2009. No order has been passed re-appointing him on contract basis for further period from 30.6.2009 to 15.7.2011 so as to claim arrears of salary. Further the petitioner has not made out case under any statutory provision to seek specific direction from this Court to appoint him as a Computer Operator. Thus, the petitioner has not made out a case so as to interfere with the claim made by him.

3.) Petition stands dismissed.
