Petitioner seeks a direction to restrain the respondents from carrying out demolition of the shop owned by him. Learned State counsel, on instructions from Naresh Kumar, SDO, PWD (B&R), Pathankot, submits that respondents do not intend to demolish the shop of the petitioner. However, there is certain encroachment which is being removed and a show cause notice has already been issued to the petitioner.

In view of statement made by learned State counsel, no further direction is necessary as there appears to be no move on behalf of the authorities to demolish the shop of the petitioner. Petitioner shall be at liberty to file his reply to the show cause notice which may be considered.
