Pleadings on record would indicate that the petitioners herein were engaged purely on contractual basis and on 89 days basis as Peons, Sewadars etc. by the District Rural Development Agency (D.R.D.A) which was an initiative of the Ministry of Rural Development, Govt. of India for implementation of various policies regarding anti poverty programmes and for implementation of other Govt. policies at the district level. Initial engagement of the petitioners was in the month of January, 2015.

Instant petition was filed praying for the issuance of a Writ of Mandamus for directing the respondents to allow the petitioners to continue in service and particularly so in the absence of any relieving order.

During the course of hearing today and in the light of the averments contained in the reply it stands uncontroverted that relieving orders thereafter have been issued and served upon the petitioners.

Confronted with such a situation counsel for the petitioners prays for withdrawal of the instant petition with liberty to raise a challenge to the relieving order(s) communicated to the petitioners on all such grounds as may be available in accordance with law.
