The present contempt petition has been filed by the petitioner as the respondents have violated the order dated 20.01.2005 (**Annexure P-3**), whereby *status-quo* regarding possession was ordered to be maintained but respondent No.1-Sat Narain (appellant therein) has sold the said land vide registered Sale Deed dated 19.12.2005 (**Annexure P-4**) to respondent No.2- Rajinder Kaushik, who is threatening to forcibly dispossess the petitioner from the land in dispute.

At the time of hearing, learned Counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from their client, submit that they have instructions to withdraw the present contempt petition.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.
