JASPAL SINGH, J. (ORAL)

Through the instant civil writ petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ, order or direction in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release the arrears after fixation of pay in IDA pattern w.e.f. January 01, 2007, in terms of Circular dated April 09, 2010 (Annexure P-1) with interest.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that though a legal notice dated September 02, 2015 (Annexure P-4) was issued to the respondents but neither any reply to the aforesaid legal notice has been received nor any final order has been passed by the respondents.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide legal notice dated September 02, 2015 (Annexure P-4) in a time bound manner.
4. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his Legal Notice dated September 02, 2015 (Annexure P-4) and pass a speaking order in terms of Circular dated April 09, 2010 (Annexure P-1) within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
4. However, if petitioner still feel aggrieved by any order of respondent No.2, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
