The petitioner alleges that the Gram Panchayat land measuring 10 marla which is a part of Khasra No.82/12 is earmarked for the development of park for the senior citizens but respondent No.5 has allegedly starting raising construction of a religious structure thereon. It is further averred that neither the Gram Panchayat has permitted him to raise such construction nor permission of the higher authorities has been obtained. It is further averred that no action is being taken by the Gram Panchayat despite a complaint made by the petitioner and other residents of the village.

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the nature of relief sought in this writ petition however without expressing any view on the merits of the allegations as the respondents have not been summoned or heard at this stage, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent Nos.3 & 4 to hold a fact-finding enquiry and take necessary remedial action in accordance with law, within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.
