Petitioners seek a direction from this court to restrain the respondents from transferring their power connections from Urban Feeder to Rural Feeder for the purpose of running their tubewells for irrigation.

It has been urged before the court that petitioners were provided electric connections through Urban Feeder, thus, they were entitled to electricity supply for 24 hours. The corporation thereafter, decided to transfer the connection from Urban to Rural Feeder. Petitioners made representation but no decision was taken thereon.

Petition is disposed of with the direction that in case petitioners make fresh representation(s) before respondent No.1 within two weeks from today, a decision thereon shall be taken within six weeks thereafter, after affording opportunity of hearing to a representative of the petitioners. Needless to observe that decision shall be taken in accordance with prevalent rules and policies.

Status quo be maintained till then.
