Prayer in the present writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of appropriate writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondent Nos.1 & 2 to not pursue further tender to any body till the decision of the appeal pending before respondent No.3 and further prayer has been sought that till the final decision of the present case, further tender/financial bids of privatization of Operation and Maintenance of Bus Terminal, Tarn Taran be stayed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the appeal which has been filed before the appropriate authority is now fixed for 23.08.2017, where the prayer made in the present writ petition shall also be adjudicated and therefore, he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to raise all possible pleas before the authority.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn. However, it shall be open to the petitioner to take recourse to the remedies as may be available to it, in accordance with law.
