In the instant writ petition, petitioners have sought for a direction to the respondents to extend benefit of arrears of difference of wages in terms of the order dated 13.05.2016 (Annexure P-9). In this regard, petitioners have not made representation or demand before the competent authority before filing the present petition. On the contrary they have rushed to this court merely stating that matter is covered by earlier decision. In the absence of demand or representation before the competent authority petitioners do not get the statutory right to seek writ of mandamus.

Accordingly, CWP stands dismissed. Reserving liberty to the petitioner to approach the competent authority. If the competent authority failed to consider their grievance in that event petitioners are at liberty to approach this court.
