Short question for consideration in the present petition is whether petitioner has challenged the validity of order of transfer dated 13.9.2005 or not?

For disobeying the order of transfer, petitioner's services have been terminated or petitioner abandoned service. As long as order of transfer is intact. Therefore, question of interference with the award passed by the Labour Court dated 26.2.2015 do not arise. Even to this day, petitioner has not challenged the order of transfer. It is clear that he has disobeyed the order of transfer. Thus, the petitioner has not made out a case so as to interfere with the award passed by the Labour Court dated 26.2.2015.

Accordingly, petition stands dismissed.
